When Max Edgar first found his way in 10 years ago, the old office units were mundane and run down, but, along with architect Jonathan Tuckey, he transformed them into the ultimate bachelor pad. 'Right from the start, fun and play were big elements,' says Jonathan. 'It's an unconventional space, and we wanted to make the most of that.' The pair clearly enjoyed filling the house with 'all sorts of little tricks'. So the big reception room has a bed that flips up into the wall and drinks cabinets hidden behind light strips, while the stairs bounce slightly as you descend them. 'I call it the Millennium Staircase,' says Max. There's also a shower that becomes a steam room and a rock-pool bath with a view, built for two – not just fun, then, but good, clean fun. • KATE LAUER
